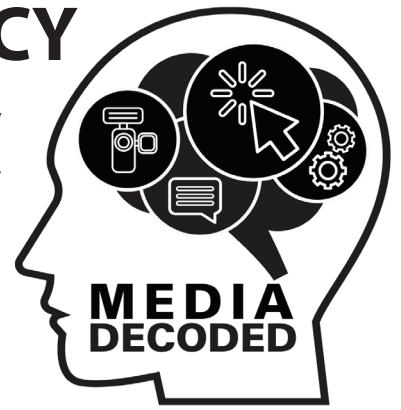


UNDERSTANDING MEDIA LITERACY

Media literacy is defined as “the ability or skills to critically analyze for accuracy, credibility, or evidence of bias the content created and consumed in various media, including radio and television, the Internet, and social media,” according to the *Dictionary.com*.
